1 Corinthians 7:17 ESV

17 Only let each person lead the life that the Lord has assigned to him, and to which God has called him. This is my rule in all the churches.

Ephesians 4:1 ESV

1 I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called,

In Christ I am called to a life of:

- a. Humble confession that I daily fall short of God's standard of Holiness
- b. Submission to God's ongoing sanctification of my life
- c. Faithful and honest representation of the Gospel.

Matthew 15:18 ESV

18 But what comes out of the mouth proceeds from the heart, and this defiles a person.

Isaiah 40:12-17 NLT

12 Who else has held the oceans in his hand? Who has measured off the heavens with his fingers? Who else knows the weight of the earth or has weighed the mountains and hills on a scale? 13 Who is able to advise the Spirit of the Lord? Who knows enough to give him advice or teach him? 14 Has the Lord ever needed anyone's advice? Does he need instruction about what is good? Did someone teach him what is right or show him the path of justice? 15 No, for all the nations of the world are but a drop in the bucket. They are nothing more than dust on the scales. He picks up the whole earth as though it were a grain of sand. 16 All the wood in Lebanon's forests and all Lebanon's animals would not be enough to make a burnt offering worthy of our God. 17 The nations of the world are worth nothing to him. In his eyes they count for less than nothing—mere emptiness and froth.

This, however, was fire from the altar, the place where holiness accepted, and was satisfied by, the death of a substitutionary sacrifice.

Leviticus 17:11 ESV

11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it for you on the altar to make atonement for your souls, for it is the blood that makes atonement by the life.

Acts 2:23 ESV

23 this Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men.

Hebrews 10:10 NLT

10 For God's will was for us to be made holy by the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ, once for all time.

Hebrews 13:12 ESV

12 So Jesus also suffered outside the gate in order to sanctify the people through his own blood.

1 Thessalonians 5:23 ESV

23 Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Leviticus 20:8 NLT

8 Keep all my decrees by putting them into practice, for I am the Lord who makes you holy.
