1 Samuel 4:1-11

The power of God:

1. Don't manipulate it
2. Don't abuse it
3. Don't underestimate it

Psalms 62:11 ESV

11 Once God has spoken; twice have I heard this: that power belongs to God,

Proverbs 16:2 ESV

2 All the ways of a man are pure in his own eyes, but the Lord weighs the spirit.

1 Thessalonians 2:4 ESV

4 but just as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, so we speak, not to please man, but to please God who tests our hearts.

Questions to consider as you serve others:

1. If there is no visible payoff, will I continue?
2. If I have to suffer, will I continue?
3. If those I'm serving don't acknowledge what I'm doing for them, will I continue?

Isaiah 55:8-9 ESV

8 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord. 9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Jeremiah 2:26-27 NLT

26 "Israel is like a thief who feels shame only when he gets caught. They, their kings, officials, priests, and prophets—all are alike in this. 27 To an image carved from a piece of wood they say, 'You are my father.' To an idol chiseled from a block of stone they say, 'You are my mother.' They turn their backs on me, but in times of trouble they cry out to me, 'Come and save us!'
