1 Samuel 24

2 Chronicles 7:14 ESV

14 If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

1 Peter 2:23 NLT

23 He did not retaliate when he was insulted, nor threaten revenge when he suffered. He left his case in the hands of God, who always judges fairly.

The cross Jesus bore is the cross the church is to bear. Giving oneself on behalf of sinners is just as integral to the gospel today as it was in days of old. Ministry is not a matter of power and privilege, but of humility and service.

Living as Christ in an in-Christian world:

1. Don't follow the crowd
2. Listen to your heart
3. Entrust yourself to God
4. Be cautious

Romans 12:21 ESV
