John reminds us we can know some things:

- 1. We know God through Jesus
- 2. We know life now is subject to the devil's evil
- 3. We know we don't have to keep on sinning
- 4. We know God hears and answers our prayers
- 5. We know we have eternal life though faith in Jesus

#### Romans 1:19-20 ESV

19 For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. 20 For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse.

## John 5:39 NLT

39 "You search the Scriptures because you think they give you eternal life. But the Scriptures point to me!
