1 Samuel 17:1-54

Stuff we learn from David:

1. Giants come in all shapes and sizes.

1 Corinthians 10:13 NLT

13 The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you can endure.

Even if your giant looks different than my giant, it's still a giant.

Stuff we learn from David:

2. Don't get distracted from dealing with your giant.

Proverbs 4:25 MSG

25 Keep vigilant watch over your heart ;that's where life starts.Don't talk out of both sides of your mouth; avoid careless banter, white lies, and gossip.Keep your eyes straight ahead; ignore all sideshow distractions.Watch your step, and the road will stretch out smooth before you.Look neither right nor left; leave evil in the dust.

Stuff we learn from David:

3. No one else can fight your giant for you

Galatians 6:5 NLT

5 For we are each responsible for our own conduct.

Stuff we learn from David:

4. All we need to face our giants is God.

Psalms 20:7 ESV

7 Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the Lord our God.

Zechariah 4:6 ESV

6 Then he said to me, "This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the Lord of hosts.

Stuff we learn from David:

5. The biggest giant of all faces an unbelievable defeat

1 Corinthians 15:55-57 ESV

55 "O death, where is your victory?O death, where is your sting?" 56 The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. 57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
